House Captain Voting

September 2017

Year 5 students wishing to be considered for a Sports House leadership position will be notified of the upcoming dates. Students must nominate themselves to the sports coordinator by the closing date.

The school will hold house meetings where

- nominated students will introduce themselves and may choose to give a short speech, no longer than 2 minutes, expressing their suitability for this role.
- absent students will remain on the ballot paper and another student or teacher may be allocated to represent them.
- each student and teacher will be given a ballot paper where a tick will be placed against two boy and two girl nominees.

At the conclusion house meetings, votes will be counted by the sports coordinator and house patrons. Once verified by an executive member, all nominees will be invited to a meeting to announce the House Captains and Vice Captains.

Note:

- House voting will not be postponed due to student absences.
- School leadership are excluded from holding these positions.
