#### 2017 Enrichment & Extension Class Nominations

The school runs small-group withdrawal classes for students identified by teachers and parents as having needs superior to most in terms of academic functioning in literacy and numeracy. I now invite parents to nominate their child for consideration into an enrichment withdrawal class for 2017. If successful, your child would be removed from their normal class for 80 minutes once a week to work with other very high achieving students. I take this opportunity to remind parents that this kind of delivery is not suited for most children and only the upper echelon of students will be considered. For the majority of students, the best place to receive quality differentiated instruction is in the general classroom. Nomination form. Nomations close on Monday.


# **Important Dates for Week 8**




# **Targeted Early Numeracy in K-2 classes**






