3. Support for wellbeing and positive behaviours

Our school's practices support student wellbeing and positive behaviour approaches that align with our school community's needs.

Social and emotional skills related to personal safety, resilience, help-seeking and protective behaviours are explicitly taught across the curriculum in Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE).

- * Wellbeing Weeks - value interpersonal relationships as a driver for positive wellbeing
- * Implement school programs e.g. Bounce Back, Anti-Bullying
- * Provide experiences that develop character by promoting self-regulation, curiosity, courage, resilience, ethics & leadership to benefit all students
- * Respond in a timely & appropriate manner to incidents of bullying
- * Student Participation and Voice - involvement in class & school committees & leadership e.g. Prefects, SRC, buddy programs, & community engagement events e.g. school concert
