

Wahroonga Public School - Playground Equipment Rules

- Students will be supervised by a teacher during school hours when playing on the equipment.
- No student is to use the equipment before the duty teacher is present and permission is given. Students are to sit and wait on the silver seat next to the equipment for the duty teacher.
- The equipment is not to be used if wet.
- A maximum of 25 students are able to use the equipment at one time.
- Playground equipment may be used by teachers for fitness during class time.
- Children are not to climb on top of or along yellow, red and purple railings and high decks of equipment. There is to be no climbing on top of any piece of equipment.
- No pushing.
- No running.
- Monkey grip (fingers on top, thumbs underneath) to be used on all equipment.
- Always use two hands to grip
- Drop to ground from two hands, feet together, knees bent, hands extended in front for balance.
- If children can't comfortably reach equipment, then they don't use it. Small children must not be lifted to reach.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times.
- Do not use equipment whilst eating
- No responsibility will be taken for children using the equipment outside of school hours and/or without supervision or permission. Parents/ guardians must supervise their children at all times.
